What happens in a Parish Council meeting?

You will find the **agenda and minutes** on the bus shelter notice board or on our website www.moreton-pinkney.org.uk. If you look at these you will find out what the council is doing and will find out what decisions are being made on behalf of residents. The **agenda** is circulated at least 3 days before the meeting.

Our Parish Council meetings start with Public time. This is the time when you as a villager can represent views of local people; tell us about what is concerning you; answer questions or give evidence relating to anything that is on the agenda. The Parish Council don't make decisions during this time, but any matters raised by the public are decided on later when the relevant agenda point comes up later in the meeting or are placed on the agenda for the next meeting. We would always like to invite you to remain after public time so that you can hear what decisions are made on topics that may interest you.

The next **Parish Council meeting** is at 7.30pm on the 13th June 2022 in the village hall.
